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SH 130, Segments 5 and 6, a concessionaire model tollway connecting IH-10 to the greater Austin toll network, is the first project of its kind in Texas. aci has integrated with other design team members including the client, engineers, and ROW acquisition to facilitate the design/build technique and fast timeline.

As the Environmental Compliance Manager for the Project, aci is under contract to provide all cultural resources compliance services for the life of the 42-mile design build project to assure ongoing compliance with 36CFR800 (Section 106) and the Texas Antiquities Code. In this role, aci has completed more than 750 acres of cultural resources surveys and has coordinated and supervised work by multiple subconsultants recording standing historic structures in rural Central Texas. In addition, aci has con-

ducted scraping and trenching activities to investigate for historic burials and has conducted Phase II testing to determine National Register of Historic Places eligibility.

In addition, aci has provided ongoing pre-construction monitoring, negotiated a monitoring protocol with TxDOT and SHPO, and worked to assess and resolve multiple post review discoveries. As the design constraints have changed over time, aci has also completed multiple NEPA reevaluations of new right-of-way and other design changes to assure compliance with an existing EIS and negotiated cultural resources protocols. Resources have ranged from early prehistoric sites as old as 8000 BC through to a sprawling early 20<sup>th</sup> century homestead.
